- Grade 12 or equivalent, accompanied by letter of employment and number of years of related experience (min 3 to 5 years' experience).
- Have acquired ECD Level 4 140 credits.
- Student must have completed year 1 Level 5 Higher Certificate of the Diploma successfully to proceed to year
 2.

- Present workshops in the ECD environment;
- Mentor students level 1,4 and 5 in-service practical training;
- Leadership roles in ECD;
