Earlier this afternoon, the Executive Committee of Senate at the Durban University of Technology, made a decision to suspend all lectures until further notice.

This decision was made following the ongoing staff strike that has affected a large number of academic programmes this week.

DUT wishes to confirm that despite the suspension of lectures, the University remains open. Student registration will still continue. Despite the staff strike, the University has already registered more than 21000 students for 2018.

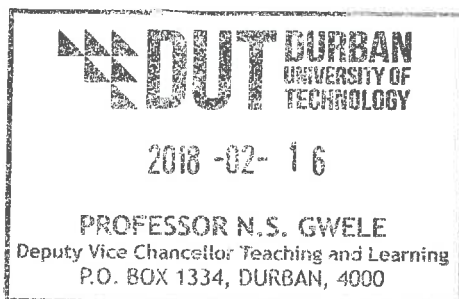
The University will announce a revised 2018 Academic calendar as soon as possible.
