## DEPARTMENT OF CHEMISTRY UNVEILS EXPANDED AND REFURBISHED LABORATORY

The Durban University of Technology's (DUT's) Department of Chemistry hosted the launch for its refurbished Wet Chemistry Laboratory at the Rendezvous Restaurant, Steve Biko Campus on Friday, 22 June 2018.

The Department of Chemistry HOD, Dr Krishan Ramluckan said he is excited about this accomplishment, and also highlighted his long-standing association with this laboratory which started many years ago.

Department of Chemistry's Professor Krishna Bisetty said this project commenced in June 2014 when they initiated engagements with the Chemical Industries Education and Training Authority (CHIETA) about possibly funding this refurbishment project.

"The original capacity per lab was for 30 students, but with this expansion the lab will now be able to service 120 students and will require less staff complement because we have now combined three labs into one lab," said Prof Bisetty.

"Part of the reason we've embarked on this lab expansion project is because the Department of Chemistry is servicing about 19/20 DUT programmes, and we needed more capacity," added Prof Bisetty.

DUT Faculty of Applied Sciences, Executive Dean Prof Suren Singh said the Faculty of Applied Sciences operates with the mantra that says educate, engage and innovate.

He said there are certain key elements that are required to drive an academic department such as the Department of Chemistry. "Research is one of key agenda that I have encouraged them to push very strongly. They have three Crated scientists, and when you look at their research output, young and seasoned researchers are producing research at the level that is equitable to any reputable University in the country. They have published over 60 research papers in international journals, and that tells you how strong they are in terms of research. This year alone the Department of Chemistry pushed four PhD graduates which is not easy," said

Prof Singh highlighted that a strong foundation accompanied by a good team and good leadership is vital. "You need a strong foundation and that is your curriculum renewal, and in terms of the key ingredients you need a good team and good leadership. The last factor is good infrastructure. If you want to push your researchers, you need to have a strong foundation, which means in the first, second and third years you need labs. You need a floor in which when a student walks in, he or she is encouraged to do chemistry," said Prof Singh.

"He (Prof Singh) went on to thank CHIETA for its generous support to the department of Chemistry.

CHIETA Acting CEO, Kedibone Moroane said they are grateful for their long-standing strategic partnership with DUT, particularly the Department of Chemistry. "CHIETA is an organisation that really drives partnerships. We really appreciate being part of this collective, and I would like to congratulate everyone who was involved in making this possible because the legacy of this lab will be felt by generations to come. We hope that we will grow from strength to strength as partners," she said.

The Wet Chemistry Laboratory is located at \$10, Level 2 at the Steve Biko Campus.

## PROF BUX APPOINTED AS CHAIR OF BRICS-NETWORK UNIVERSITY SPECIALIST GROUP

The Durban University of Technology's Institute for Water and Wastewater Technology (IWWT), Director, Professor Faizal Bux says his appointment as the Chairperson of the BRICS Network University International Thematic Group on Water Resource and Pollution Treatment will position DUT at an international level.

"Serving as the Chair of the ITG will certainly have benefits which include profiling the Institute and the University at the international level. This will also facilitate collaboration and being part of an international network of scientists and practitioners all working towards a common goal. Access to resources and student and staff exchange is another major advantage," said Prof Bux.

According to Prof Bux the BRICS Network University (BRICS-NU) is a network of BRICS member countries of higher education institutions, engaged in corporation of educational projects including postgraduate training programmes. BRICS Network University International Thematic Groups (ITGs) are structures within the BRICS-NU responsible for the coordination of work and research activities related to the six priority/knowledge areas which have been identified for BRICS cooperation.

"These knowledge areas are: Energy; Computer Science and Information Security; BRICS Studies; Ecology and Climate Change; Water Resources and Pollution Treatment; as well as Economics. The Durban University of Technology (DUT) has established a strong track record in water and wastewater treatment research and therefore was selected as the Lead organisation for South Africa, for the ITG Water Resources and Pollution Treatment," explained Prof Bux.

Prof Bux gave more details on how his appointment to this prominent position came about. "As the leading Water specialist for South Africa, I was nominated during 2016, to represent South Africa on the ITG. At the annual BRICS-NU conference held at the University of Stellenbosch in July 2018, the ITG members from BRICS representative countries nominated me as Chair of the ITG for two years with the option of a second term," he said.

He also outlined the objective of the International Thematic Group - Water Resources and Pollution Treatment, as well as his responsibilities as the Chairperson.

"Our main purpose is to contribute to the development of water security concepts that will encompass issues on wastewater treatment and urbanisation, surface water pollution and basin level water resources analysis. As Chair, my responsibilities are to co-ordinate the activities of the ITG, as well as to enhance co-operation and exchanges among all member nations and universities, strengthening their visibility, impact and competitiveness amongst BRICS countries. Each country is represented by two universities on the ITG management committee, however other universities may also participate in the activities of the ITG," said Prof Bux.

"At the recent, BRICS-NU conference, a roadmap was approved by the ITG members, outlining the activities planned for the next two years. The ITG seeks to develop joint initiatives in education and research through joint research projects, network implementation of collaborative Master and PhD programmes, short courses and seminars for students, conferences and joint publications," he added.

Prof Bux said he is humbled and honoured by his appointment to this prominent position. "The position comes with a great degree of responsibility which I intend to fulfil to the best of my ability. I am honoured to be nominated to this position by my fellow BRICS ITG members to oversee the activities of five nations. I will strive to achieve the desired objectives of the ITG as the Chair," he said.
