FRAMEWORK FOR THE MEDIATION PROCESS

PRINCIPLE PREAMBLE:

In the meeting facilitated by the Deputy Minister of Higher Education and Training, at DUT Council Chambers, 8rd Floor D Block, at ML Sultan Campus on 27 February 2018;

The Parties agreed to the following terms:

- 1. To revert to the mediation process under the auspices of the CCMA.
- 2. The three variables across the board increases, housing allowance and the once-off bonus will be the focus of the mediation process.

Across the board increase: 6.5% - 8.5%

Once-Off Bonus: R7,500

Housing Allowance: R200 - R400

- 3. The implementation of the no work no pay principle will form part of the negotiations.
- 4. The above framework shall lead to the suspension of the strike with the academic programme resuming on 1 March 2018.
- 5. The mediation process will commence on 28 February at 10h00 and be concluded within a three day period.
- The Deputy Minister, the Chairperson of the Council and the General-Secretaries of NEHAWU and FEDUSA will monitor progress of the mediation process.
