

## IMPORTANT MESSAGE FOR DUT STUDENTS

12 June 2020

Dear students

As DUT students and staff begin returning to campus, please allow us to stress some extremely important guidelines that ALL students must follow:

- → If you have symptoms of illness, do not come to campus.
- → If you have symptoms of illness and you live in res., immediately contact your Residence Advisor.
- → Do not attend lectures or practical's.
- → Do not come into close contact with others. Practice good hand hygiene and self-isolate for 14 days. Inform your lecturers.
- → If you have symptoms, and you do not live in res., please stay at home and self-quarantine for 14 days. Inform your lecturers.
- → If you fall ill while on campus, contact your nearest DUT Health Clinic as follows:

→ Any student, who fails to disclose their symptoms as above as soon as possible, may face disciplinary action and possible suspension.

#### Important information about returning to campus:

- Please do not come to campus if your name is not on your department's accreditation list for those allowed back onto campus.
- Only those students who have been accredited to return on a particular date will be allowed back onto campus on and after that date.
- → Please note that any student, who arrives at DUT when their name is not on the list of accredited students scheduled to return, will be denied access to DUT.

### To gain entry to all DUT campus, you are required to:

- Please complete the HealthCheck online form before coming to campus. Only proceed to campus if you get the green light. (See below for how to access the HealthCheck online screening form).
- Please wear a mask to campus.
- Please present your staff/student card to security at the entrances.
- Please co-operate with staff at DUT campus entrances who will take your temperature and further screen you, if necessary.
- Please sanitise your hands at DUT campus entrances.
- If applicable, please show your car's parking disk.
- If applicable, please allow random inspection of your vehicle.
- → Please note that any student or staff member who fails to comply with these requirements will be denied access to DUT.
