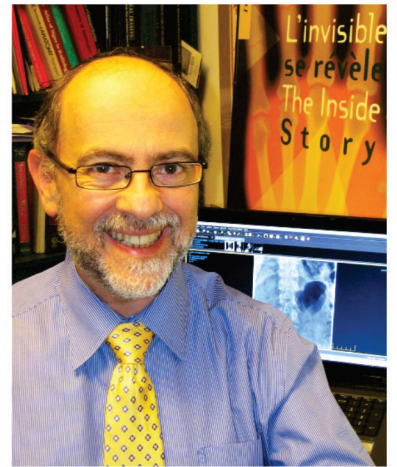
Radiography Review for Chiropractic
