Competition Rules:

1. The competition is open to all high and primary schools.
2. All video clip entries must be submitted by Monday, 9 November 2020, to WhatsApp number 0647731318.
3. Required format of entries: MP4 format.
4. Required length of entries: 2 minutes (minimum) and 4 minutes (maximum).
5. Required number of participants per dance group: 5 (minimum) and 10 (maximum).
6. All participants in each dance group must belong to the same school.
7. All dancers and participants in the video must wear a face mask. If dancers/participants do not wear a face mask, then the video recording will not be considered by the judges.
8. Competition criteria: dance step execution; passion and energy; creativity
9. By entering this competition, the school gives DUT permission to use their videos and photos on media platforms.

Prizes awarded to the top three schools (in primary and high school categories):

- ★ 1st prize school: framed certificate and R 10 000 voucher
- ★ 1st prize team: branded t-shirts and R500 book voucher per team member
- ★ 2nd prize school: framed certificate and R 8 000 voucher
- ★ 2nd prize team: branded t-shirts and R300 book voucher per team member
- ★ 3rd prize school: framed certificate and R 5 000 voucher
- ★ 3rd prize team: branded t-shirts
