Dr. Jos Beelen is Professor of Global Learning at The Hague University of Applied Sciences. He leads a research group that explores internationalisation at home, particularly the skills of lecturers to develop and teach internationalised curricula. This research group also researches how internationalisation in higher education connects with internationalisation in secondary and vocational education. Jos has published a range of articles on the implementation of internationalisation at home, both from educational and organisational perspectives.

He is a Visiting Professor at Coventry University and a senior trainer for the European Association for International Education (EAIE). From that association he was the recipient of the 2018 President's Award for his contribution to internationalisation at home.
