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Fulufhelo (Fulu) Netswera holds a DPhil in Development Sociology and MPhil in Social Science Methods from Stellenbosch. He is a 2004 Emerging Philanthropy Fellow at City University of New York (CUNY), a former associate

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professor at Tshwane University of Technology (TUT) and Uganda Technology and Management University (UTAMU). Fulu has published extensively in higher education management, governance, entrepreneurship and philanthropy. He is the current Executive Dean of the Faculty of Management Sciences at the Durban University of Technology.



Professor Sibusiso Moyo holds a PhD in Mathematics from the University of Natal, Durban and a Masters (with distinction) in Tertiary Education Management from the LH Martin Institute, University of Melbourne Australia. As a scholar, she has published widely in the Mathematical Sciences with a focus on differential equations and
