

REGISTRATION WITH ENGINEERING COUNSEILOF SOUTH AFRICA (ECSA)

Students who completed their studies and graduate with the BEngTech degrees are eligible to register as “Professional Engineering Technologists”, with the Engineering Council of South Africa (ECSA), after obtaining a minimum of four years practical experience.

The BEngTech degree is recognized globally through the Sydney Accord, hence graduates are eligible to work as Engineering Technologists signatory countries to the accord.

For example, in the United Kingdom, upon registering with the Engineering Council of the United Kingdom, an Engineering Technologist may serve as an Incorporated Engineer (I Eng.) (ECUK) in the UK.

The Bachelor of Engineering Technology (BEngTech) degree has a strong focus on practical applications hence Engineering Technologists are competent engineering practitioners who can apply and modify engineering in novel ways.
