

COUNSELLING PSYCHOLOGY 5 X INTERNSHIP POST: YEAR 2022

Durban and Midlands

The Student Counselling and Health department under the Durban University of Technology Wellness Centre is an accredited training institution with the Health Professions Council of South Africa (HPCSA) and is seeking to appoint **Counselling Psychologist Interns for the year 2022** for both campuses (Durban and Midlands). The internship commences on 01 January 2022 till 31 December 2022.

The intern will be expected, under supervision, to render professional services aimed at facilitating and supporting the academic, personal, interpersonal and career development of students, and to a lesser extent staff and prospective students.

The intern will be required to offer a number of psychological services (under supervision), and as such experience in many or all of these areas would be a distinct advantage:

- Individual and group-based therapy
- Crisis Intervention
- Career Counselling
- Academic Guidance and Support
- Developing and implementation of various interventions
- Provide different psycho-education programmes
- Conducting Formal Psychological Assessments
- Conducting basic research and needs assessments
- Engage in Continuous Professional Development trainings

PLEASE NOTE: that the placement of interns will be in either the Durban or the Midlands campus, but the provision of services and training will be done jointly across our campuses.

Minimum Requirements:

- Current proof of registration with HPCSA as a Student Psychologist
- Evidence of completion of the M1 examinations at the beginning of internship
- Registration with the HPCSA as a Counselling Intern Psychologist for 2022
- Valid Driver's license
- Evidence of completion or near completion of Master dissertation at commencement of internship year. A letter from your Research Supervisor from your training institution may be required at commencement of your internship. Computer literacy

Applications should include:

- A detailed curriculum vitae (explicitly stating experience or knowledge in above-mentioned fields)
- Certified copy of identification document.
- Certified certificates of all relevant university academic records and certificates.
- Certified copy of HPCSA Student Psychologist Certificate.
- Current contact information of three referees (one of which must include a direct clinical/therapy supervisor).
- One typed motivation page explaining why you have applied to complete your internship at the Durban University of Technology, Student Counselling Centre and your exposure or experience in psychotherapeutic interventions (both online and in-person) as well as exposure in conducting formal psychological assessments.

Please note when applying please put all required documentation on one PDF document. Multiple documents will not be accepted. Details of the interview will be sent closer to the time.
