Mr Mfanozelwe Shozi has more than 24 years of experience and knowledge working in public participation, human rights, gender equality, and community development, including while working for the Commission for Gender Equality in the past 15 years. He has been involved in promoting active citizenship and developing participatory democracy programmes, including voter education and civic organisation. Within the Commission for Gender Equality, the scope of operation involved educating communities about gender equality, receiving and dealing with gender-related complaints, conducting research, monitoring and evaluating the implementation of gender programmes. He has served on the SABC commission tasked to investigate sexual harassment at the SABC and has provided advisory services to the Dennis Hurley centre on the inclusion of homeless people in the elections; advisory services to the KZN society for the blind on their GBV programme. Mr Shozi is also a recipient of a fellowship with University of Sydney in 2016. As the Chairperson of the CGE, Mr Shozi has represented CGE on a yearly basis on the United Nations on the status of women conference, which takes place every March. Currently serves as the Chairperson of the Board member for The Valley Trust, Deputy Chairperson of African Child and Youth Community Development Project (ACYCDP) and a Project Manager at DUT's Imbali Education and innovation Precinct. He holds MA in Community Development (UKZN), Bachelor of Arts (Natal), B-Tech administration (Technikon South Africa), Diploma in adult basic education (Natal), and is currently reading for a PHD on Peace Studies Durban University of Technology (DUT).
