### REOPENING OF THE FIVE DURBAN CAMPUSES

Please note that following ongoing negotiations with the SRC, daily engagements with security and law enforcement and multiple discussions with the National Students Financial Aids Scheme (NSFAS), we have decided to reopen all five Durban campuses that were temporarily closed following the recent violent protests by a group of students.

Therefore, operations will resume on the Brickfield campus, City campus, M.L Sultan campus, Ritson campus and the Steve Biko campus on **Monday, 15 November 2021**.

We thank you for your patience and understanding during this critical time.

Please remember that we are still in Alert Level 1 of the “National State of Disaster” so you must continue to follow all COVID-19 protocols and do your best to limit the expected fourth wave of the pandemic. Mask up, get fully vaccinated and help stop the spread of the virus.
