UPDATE ON CAMPUS ACTIVITIES IN DURBAN FOLLOWING THE MUNICIPAL WATER SUPPLY ISSUES

Further to the official university statement that we shared with you via email and published on our website earlier today, <https://dut-cdn2.azureedge.net/wp-content/uploads/2022/05/DUT.Statement.300522.pdf>, we would like to inform you that all on-campus activities at the Brickfield Campus, City Campus, ML Sultan Campus, Ritson Campus and the Steve Biko Campus will remain suspended on Tuesday, 31 May 2022.

Staff from the five affected campuses must continue to work remotely. All students who are based on the Durban campuses must please continue with their academic activities online.

The University has not received a specific date as to when the municipal water supply will be restored. Tomorrow evening after 18H00, we will update you on the situation for Wednesday. Please continue to monitor the DUT PinBoard (staff email system) and DUT4life (student email account) for official updates.
