UPDATE ON CAMPUS ACTIVITIES IN DURBAN FOLLOWING THE MUNICIPAL WATER SUPPLY ISSUES

We have received reports that Umgeni Water has started to resume some of the municipal water supply to a few areas in Durban that have been without water for a number of days. Whilst some taps are starting to run, reports of low water pressure has also been reported but there seems to be progress since Monday. However, we are still uncertain as to when the requisite municipal water supply will be fully restored.

Therefore, please note that all on-campus activities at the Brickfield Campus, City Campus, ML Sultan Campus, Ritson Campus and the Steve Biko Campus will remain suspended on Thursday, 02 June 2022.

Staff from the five affected campuses must continue to work remotely. All students who are based on the Durban campuses must continue with online academic activities.

Please note that tomorrow evening, we will update you on the situation for Friday. We kindly advise you to monitor the DUT PinBoard (staff email system) and the DUT4life (student email account) for official updates.
