#### SUMMARIZED DHET REQUIREMENTS FOR PUBLICATIONS SUBMISSION

## 1. DOCUMENTS TO BE SUBMITTED WITH EACH OUTPUT Journals

- An <u>already published</u> journal article or copy of the Journal article.
- <u>DO NOT</u> submit copies of articles that are "Still in Press or copies where the Date, Volume and Page numbers do not appear.

### Proceedings; Books and Book Chapters

If an original copy of proceeding is not submitted, make sure that clear and readable copies are provided. **Submissions should include:** 

- The cover of the publication (Showing the title)
- The imprint pages of the publication showing the date publication, ISSN or ISBN and the contents page;
- The pages of the book or conference proceedings reflecting the index, table of content, bibliography, etc.
- The full contribution being claimed and
- The pages showing author affiliation if this is not indicated anywhere in the proceeding.

#### Further Requisite for Books/Chapters (Without this DHET will not accept the submission)

A justification (maximum of 500 words) signed by the author of the book, or the general editor (in the case of an edited book with several chapters from various contributors) explaining the contribution that the book makes to scholarship must be attached to each book/chapter publication claim.

The justification should not be an abstract of the contents or preface of the book, but should, rather describe the methodology used as well as the unique contribution made to knowledge production. It should be clear that the book or chapter against which subsidy is being claimed disseminates original research and new developments within the specific discipline. As part of the justification, there must be unequivocal declaration to the fact that no part of the work was plagiarized or published elsewhere. The target audience must be stated.

# 2. EVIDENCE OF PEER REVIEW (Provide clear Proof of Review for Proceedings and Books & Chapters)

All publications submitted for research subsidy should be peer reviewed. **Guidelines regarding peer review and evidence of peer review for Books/Chapters & Proceedings should be as follows:** 

- Peer review must be by specialists in the field;
- Peer review must be done <u>prior to publication;</u>
- Full articles and not just abstracts (as it is the case with some conferences), must be peer reviewed'
- Conference papers or articles must be reviewed for publication and not only for presentation;
- Authors and Editors cannot be part of the peer review process of their own papers;
- **Emails from authors** confirming peer review are not considered to be sufficient evidence; and Evidence of peer review should be **un-ambiguous**
