UPSET PROJECT WORKSHOP:

BRIDGING THE DIVIDE BETWEEN TVET AND HEI CURRICULA AND QUALIFICATIONS.

Sections 43(3) and 43(4) of the FET Colleges Act (as amended) enable the joint offering of higher certificates by Technical and Vocation Education and Training (TVET) colleges and partner Higher Education Institutions (HEIs).

Offering of such higher certificates may shift articulation from *pockets of articulation initiatives* supported through informal networks to *articulation by design*. Such articulation should be driven by communities of practice across the Post School Education and Training (PSET) sector. Establishing sustainable articulation partnerships should ensure that articulation becomes the norm rather than the exception across the PSET system.

None of the KZN TVET colleges and HEIs have exploited this option. The purpose of the workshop is to establish protocols for jointly offered new and additional Higher Certificates (Figure 1).
