





DUTIES OF THE VOTER TO ONESELF:

- 
Check the voters roll to see if you are registered within your respective residence.
- 
If not registered, make sure that you are registered at the Student Housing Administration Office before the date of voting
- 
Ensure that your phone number is captured correctly on the ITS system.
- 
If your phone number has changed since registration, register your new phone number on the ITS system

DUTIES OF THE VOTER TO THE PROCESS & STRENGTHENING OF DEMOCRACY:

- 
Check the preliminary list of candidates on the date of publications
- 
If you know of grounds of disqualifications of any particular candidate, report such providing relevant proof
- 
Please click on provided link on DUT House Committee Elections web page to complete form to lodge objection or appeal
- 
Acquaint yourself with the grounds for eligibility to stand for the House Committee [Section 8-House Committee Constitution]
- 
If you observe someone breaking the rules of electioneering, report them
- 
Please click on provided link on DUT House Committee Elections web page to complete form to report misconduct
- 
Whilst online electioneering and campaigning is permitted, the social media policy of the university is still enforced.
- 
Using login details of others fraudulently to second a nomination or to vote will lead to disciplinary action.
- 
It is forbidden to willingly allow somebody else to use your login details to vote or to second others
- 
Coercion of others to vote in a particular way or in any way exercise their rights in a particular way is strictly forbidden
-
