DUTIES OF THE VOTER TO ONESELF



Check the voter's roll to see if you are registered

If not registered, make sure that you are registered at your faculty before the date of voting

Ensure that your phone number is captured correctly on the ITS system

3



If your phone number has changed since registration, register your new phone number on the ITS system

DUTIES OF THE VOTER TO THE PROCESS AND STRENGTHENING OF DEMOCRACY



Check the preliminary list of candidates on the date of publication

If you know of grounds for disqualification of any particular candidates, report such providing relevant proof

If you observe someone breaking the rules of electioneering, report them
