The Disability Rights Unit (DRU) strives to create an inclusive DUT community that is rooted in cultivating and promoting inclusivity and accessibility for Students With Disabilities (SWD). This supports the DUT ENVISION2030 ethos of creating people who will be innovative, entrepreneurial and adaptive to changes in the world.

The increasing enrolment of students with disabilities at DUT reflects the changing landscape of the University. Efforts to enhance access and participation for individuals with disabilities are also aligned with national efforts. However, despite initiatives, people with disabilities continue to face underrepresentation in education, employment and social engagement due to deeply ingrained myths and misconceptions surrounding disability.

To address these challenges, the DRU will be facilitating a Disability Equality Training (DET) Programme that empowers individuals to understand and recognize the systemic exclusion faced by individuals with disabilities.
