Learning and Teaching Excellence Awards (LTEA) categories

[Distinguished Student Excellence Awards \(Stewardship\)](#)

Awarded to students UG, PG, Masters PhD who demonstrate exceptional academic. Students that have an academic record of minimum 75% average is eligible for this award, demonstrating continuous excellence in academic and co-curricular endeavours. This award serves as acknowledgment for their devotion, hard work, and dedication to achieving academic excellence. Nominees is set to graduate in the required period of the programme.

[Innovative Instructional Leader Award \(Stewardship\)](#)

In line with DUT philosophy of education, the award recognises staff who bring creativity and fresh approaches to teaching, for making a major difference in the lives of their students, colleagues, and the larger educational community. Celebrates teaching staff who have demonstrated originality, efficacy, and had a major influence in their teaching and learning methodologies. This award seeks to encourage and recognise innovative ways that increase student participation, facilitate deeper learning, and improve the overall quality of education. Awards recognise the development and use of new technologies, Use of teaching methods or learning experiences that improve student engagement and learning outcomes.
