The university is pleased to provide the following important updates regarding the commencement of the 2025 academic year.

COMMENCEMENT OF THE ACADEMIC PROGRAMME (LECTURES)

We are pleased to confirm that lectures for the 2025 academic year will commence as scheduled on **Monday**, **I0 February 2025**, in accordance with the approved academic calendar.

We extend a warm welcome to all new and returning students. As you embark on this academic journey, we look forward to engaging with you in a year filled with learning, growth, and academic excellence. Our faculty and staff remain committed to supporting your success, and we are excited to start this new chapter with you.

REGISTRATION AND LATE REGISTRATION FOR THE 2025 ACADEMIC YEAR

As of **7 February 2025**, at **9:00**, a total of **25 411 students** have successfully registered. While we acknowledge the technical challenges that some students have encountered, we assure you that every effort is being made to resolve these issues swiftly. We appreciate your patience and understanding during this time.

The initial registration period commenced approximately a week late on **21 January 2025** and concludes today, **7 February 2025**. However, students who have not yet registered will have another opportunity during the **Iate registration period, which will run from Monday, 10 February 2025, to Friday, 21 February 2025**.



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Students who meet the academic eligibility criteria for registration but have been unable to complete their registration due to system-related delays or other challenges will be permitted to attend lectures between 10 and 21 February 2025 while they finalize the registration process. However, this concession will only apply during the late registration period and will end on 21 February 2025. We strongly encourage all affected students to complete their registration as soon as possible to prevent disruptions to their academic progress.

STUDENT RESIDENCES

- **First-time entering students**. Prospective students arriving on campus without having registered academically will not be accommodated in student residences. However, a principal agreement has been established for applicants with firm offers who encounter registration challenges. These applicants are welcome to come onto campus and will be accommodated in student residences while finalizing their registration.
- Returning students who applied for residence and have received an "Accepted for Residence" status will only be accommodated once they have completed their academic registration. Accommodation will be available 48 hours prior to the commencement of lectures.
