## PRECAUTIONARY SUSPENSIONS ISSUED AFTER DISRUPTION IN THE MIDLANDS

Following the disruptions that occurred at the Indumiso Campus in the Midlands yesterday, the university has taken decisive action by issuing precautionary suspensions to the four students who were allegedly responsible for the disruption.

Durban University of Technology upholds a commitment to providing a safe and conducive environment for teaching and learning. The university will not tolerate any form of violence, intimidation or disruption that compromises the well-being of our staff and students.

We realise that certain elements will do their best to threaten campus operations in an effort to try and disrupt the academic programme and sometimes, they may even resort to criminal behaviour. We urge all staff and students to report all related incidents to the Protection Services Unit.
