Planned National Protest Action – Tuesday, 30 June 2026

The Durban University of Technology (DUT) is aware of the planned national protest action scheduled to take place on Tuesday, 30 June 2026.

Although the University is currently observing its mid-year recess, a number of staff members remain on duty across our campuses, while some postgraduate and Work-Integrated Learning (WIL) students remain in residence during the recess.

The University wishes to assure the DUT community that all campuses will remain open and normal operations will continue on Tuesday, 30 June 2026.

At the same time, we encourage all staff and students to remain vigilant and to place their personal safety first. Should protest action result in road closures, disruptions to public transport or any situation that could compromise your safety, please exercise sound judgement and take the necessary precautions. DUT Protection Services will limit campus access points should the protest flare up.

The University will continue to monitor the situation closely and will communicate any significant developments through its official communication channels, should the need arise. We remind you that all official University Statements are published on the DUT website, the DUT WhatsApp channel and via the Pinboard (staff) and DUT4life (students) email accounts.
