DUT Support of PG Students!

- 100% Fee Remission FT & PT Studies till 2014.
- (To increase PG enrolments. Total cost per student ~ R16000 R25000).
- Competitive scholarships @ R36000 p.a. (Ms) and R48000 p.a. (Ds) for 2 and 3 years respectively.
- Full cost for an M (R72000) and for a D (R144000).

DUT Support of PG Students!

Research Running Costs for M and D projects:

R10000 (M) and R15000 (D).

- Full Cost for Student Support = Tuition fee + Research Running expenses + DUT Scholarship.
- M~ R82000 and D~R159000.

- To produce another 300 units over the next 5 years.
- To create capacity within DUT by stimulating an increase in Staff Qualifications
- Postgraduate enrolments and Graduations, Research Outputs.

- PDF fellowships (DUT/NRF/External Foundations/ DHET)
- MTech &DTech Scholarships (NRF/ DUT/ External Trusts, agencies and science councils)

UNIVERSITY STAFF PROFILE

- Staff Qualifications Ms and Ds ~13% of staff with Ds.
- Staff Research Productivity 0.5 units per fulltime academic staff ~300units. Currently ~ 74.
- 1 unit ~ R120 000 to DUT

To find ways in which to collaborate and establish beneficial partnerships that would assist the University increase its Research Capacity and Postgraduate Outputs.

ALLOCATION OF UNITS

- A book = 5 units (depending on length)
- (Doctoral Degree = 3 units)
- \rightarrow A journal article (Research M) = 1 unit.
- A book chapter = a fraction calculated from 5 units.
- Conference Proceedings = 0.5 unit.
- If more than one author from different institutions authored an article/book, the units are divided between the institutions accordingly.


DHET FUNDING - OUTPUT SUBSIDY
