

Why are ARVs important if I am HIV positive?

ARVs slow down the progression of HIV and prevents multiplication of the virus.

Dear Sister Zee

Is it important to use a condom if both my partner and I are HIV positive?

You can both be HIV positive but at different life stages of the virus, with different strains of the virus. Therefore, sustained condom use is important to prevent re-infection.

Dear Sister Zee

I am HIV positive, when would you say is the right time for me to join a support group?

When you are ready to talk about your status and need support. Individuals often join a support group immediately after discovering they are HIV positive.

Dear Sister Zee

How long does it take for HIV to develop into AIDS?

Every individual's immune system differs depending on their lifestyle and diet. A strong immune system is more capable to fight opportunistic infections in conjunction with a healthy lifestyle. Continuous use of condoms will prevent re-infection. HIV has four stages, however, after the third stage the virus develops into full blown AIDS. The healthier the lifestyle, the longer it takes to reach this stage.
